### Art: Program Overview

OSU-Cascades Campus offers a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree with an option in Studio Art. The curriculum provides an awareness and understanding of the historical and contemporary significance of art as a unique feature of society.

The OSU-Cascades Art program offers the opportunity for professional artistic development while incorporating subjects that lead to a liberal education. These major programs prepare the student for a range of professional opportunities or later graduate study in graphic design, advertising, communications, photography, fine art, and art history.

### OSU Graduation Requirements:

- 180—total number of credits required to graduate from OSU
- 60—number of upper division credits required
- 124—maximum number of credits which can be transferred from a community college
- 45 of last 75 credits must be OSU credits
- Maintain a 2.0 or better university GPA

### Important Notes:

- OSU-Cascades Art major incorporates studio and art history courses only offered at COCC.
- Not all the courses listed are offered each term. Check current schedule for availability and pre-reqs.
- No Art department courses can be applied to Bacc Core and CLA Core.
- AAOT degree completes Skills and Perspectives requirements in Bacc Core.
- **It is the student's responsibility to track progress and know all degree requirements. The advisor can suggest courses and assist the student in constructing a plan of study, but the student, in the end, is responsible for assuring all requirements for graduation are met. Read all requirements carefully.**

**B.S. Degree Requirement** is a 15-credit block of science, computer science and quantitative studies as follows:

1. Any computer science (CS) course approved by the student's advisor (3-4), sample CS 160 or CS 391
2. Any course from the College of Science except math or statistics (3-4 credits)
3. One of the following MTH/ST (8 - 12 credits):
  - A. ST 351 and ST 352 (8 credits)
  - B. MTH 111 and MTH 245 (8 credits)
  - C. MTH 241 or MTH245 or MTH251, and ST 351 (8 credits).
  - D. Any 8 credits of MTH courses at the 200 level or above (NOT including MTH 243 and MTH 244 at COCC) (MTH 241, 245, 251)
