Students are required to meet the University Graduation requirements as well as complete course work required for their major to graduate with a Bachelor of Science/Arts in Hospitality Management.

- 180 total college credits (124 max transferred from a community college)
- 60 upper division credits
- 45 out of last 75 credits must be OSU credits

Important Notes:

- Hospitality Mgmt. major is a new degree; courses are not yet offered each year. Transfer students would not be able to complete program through a traditional academic year plan.
- Culinary courses are offered through COCC Culinary Institute as indicated. Transfer work from other culinary institutes in Oregon are also accepted. Connect with advisor for details.
- It is the student's responsibility to make certain that all prerequisites are met or instructor approval is granted for courses that require one or both of these conditions.
- Students who complete the HM curriculum are also completing the Business and Entrepreneurship Minor. Students must declare this minor through an online orientation process. Find details at the OSU-Cascades Hospitality Mgmt Option website.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all degree requirements are met. The advisor can suggest courses and assist the student in constructing a plan of study, but the student in the end is responsible for assuring all requirements for graduation are complete.
