Working toward your Psychology degree consists of the Major requirements, Bacc Core requirements, CLA Core Requirements, BA or BS requirements. The following document has info on each of the above.

OSU Graduation Requirements:

- 180—total number of credits required to graduate from OSU
- 60—number of upper division credits required
- 124—maximum number of credits which can be transferred from a community college
- 45 of last 75 credits must be OSU credits
- Maintain a 2.0 or better university GPA
- Only courses with grades of C- or better (S/U is not acceptable) may be used to fulfill the major requirements

IMPORTANT: Courses may NOT be used to meet more than one requirement. Exceptions are

- In the Major and in the Bacc Core
 - OSU BI 102/103 or COCC BI 101, BI 102, & BI 103
 - OSU WR 327 or COCC WR 227 courses
- In the Major and in the CLA BS requirements
 - OSU ST 351 & ST 352
- Not all the courses listed are offered each term. Check current schedule for availability.
- It is the student's responsibility to make certain that all prerequisites are met or instructor permission is granted for courses that require one or both of these conditions.
- It is the responsibility of the student to continuously audit his/her program for successful completion of requirements.
- No Psychology courses can be used in the Bacc Core or CLA Core.
