# Art History Minor Checklist

## OSU-Cascades

### Minor Requirement Information:

- At least 31 credits in Art, at least 15 of which are at the upper division level.

**NOTE:** Due to the credit differences between COCC offerings and OSU requirements, students completing the Art History minor at OSU-Cascades will typically need 35 credits to complete the minor.

### Important Notes:

- Not all the courses listed are offered each term. Check current schedule for availability.
- It is the student's responsibility to make certain that all prerequisites are met or instructor permission is granted for courses that require one or both of these conditions.
- **It is the student's responsibility to double check that all requirements are met. The advisor can suggest courses and assist the student in constructing a plan of study, but the student, in the end, is responsible for assuring all requirements for graduation are met.**
- Art History Minor students may not elect to take required art courses on an S/U graded basis.

### Art History Minor: A Degree Overview

The minor in Art History is designed for students in any major. Students take introductory and lower-division art history classes at COCC, and then further their study at the upper-division level through OSU-Cascades. The program prepares students for a range of professional opportunities or later graduate study in the arts.
