CACREP Program Outcomes Report

MCoun in Clinical Mental Health Counseling

The CMH program is accredited until March 2023. OSU is committed to continuing CACREP accreditation, and we successfully passed the CACREP self-study and site visit in the fall of 2015, earning full accreditation for the next 8 years.

In 2015, the CMH program had 21 graduates. Approximately 99% of enrolled students completed the program. 100% of students taking the National Counselor Examination passed. 95% of graduates seeking a job within the mental health counseling field obtained a job within 6 months of graduation.

The Program currently enrolls 48 CMH students, which is split between students in the full-time and part-time programs in years 1, 2, and 3. The Program received 126 total applications for admission, which comprised both the CMH and School Counseling Programs. An average class size for CMH specific courses is 19-23 students. Combined classes average a class size of 30 students. Practica courses enroll 12 or less students. Triadic supervision occurs at a ratio of two students to one faculty supervisor.

MCoun in School Counseling

The School Counseling program is accredited until March 2023. OSU is committed to continuing CACREP accreditation, and we successfully passed the CACREP self-study and site visit in the fall of 2015, earning full accreditation for the next 8 years.

In 2015, the School Counseling program had 2 graduates. 99% of enrolled students completed the program. 100% of students taking the National Counselor Examination passed. 100% percent

of graduates seeking a job within the school counseling field obtained a job within 6 months of graduation.

The School Counseling program currently enrolls 72 students, which is split between students in the full-time and hybrid programs, as well as years 1, 2, and 3. The Program received 126 total applications for admission, which comprised both the CMH and School Counseling Programs. An average class size for School specific courses is 11-15 students. Combined classes average a class size of 30 students. Practica courses enroll 12 or less students. Triadic supervision occurs at a ratio of two students to one faculty supervisor.

Ph.D. in Counseling (Counselor Education & Supervision)

The Ph.D. in Counseling program is accredited until March 2023. OSU is committed to continuing CACREP accreditation, and we successfully passed the CACREP self-study and site visit in the fall of 2015, earning full accreditation for the next 8 years.

In 2015, the Ph.D. program had 7 graduates. 84% of enrolled students completed the program. 100% percent of graduates seeking a job as a counselor educator or supervisor obtained a job within 6 months of graduation.

The Ph.D. program currently enrolls 66 students, which is split between in years 1, 2, 3, and 4. The Ph.D. Program received 25 total applications for admission. An average class size for Ph.D. courses is 11-15 students.
