<u>HEALING JUSTICE COLLECTIVE OF CENTRAL OREGON</u> - High-quality, accessibly priced, BIPOC-led Services for Emotional, Mental, and physical well-being.

<u>MECCABEND</u> - Mecca Bend is an online directory assistance program that enables the Latinx Community of Central Oregon to find the necessary resources for work support programs, family assistance, education, housing, local events, and much more.

<u>CENTRAL OREGON DIVERSITY PROJECT</u> (C.O.D.P) - C.O.D.P. is dedicated to uplifting BIPOC voices and experiences, and information that affects our Central Oregon communities. Restorative Justice & Equity (RJ&E) Group - The RJ&E Group is a volunteer advocacy group that encourages Bend-La Pine schools to use restorative justice practices to raise academic and social engagement as well as retention and graduation rates for low-income students and students of color. We also utilize restorative justice principles to facilitate Town Hall Symposiums on race for high school students of color.
