



B.A./B.S. - Hospitality Management Curriculum Checklist 24-25

The undergraduate curriculum in hospitality management provides students with the knowledge necessary to become leaders, executives, and owners in the hospitality industry. The course work provides students with skills in service, operations management, hospitality technology, food and beverage operations as well as basic business fundamentals in marketing and accounting.

To complete a Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management students complete each area below.

1. OSU Graduation Requirements

3. Hospitality Management Major Curriculum
4. Business & Entrepreneurship Minor Curriculum
5. Optional - Ecotourism and Sustainability Specialization Optional Specialization

OSU Graduation Requirements:

- 180—total number of credits required to graduate from OSU
- 60—number of upper division credits required
- 124—maximum number of credits that will transfer from a community college
- 45 of last 75 credits must be OSU credits
- Maintain a 2.0 or higher university GPA

Degree planning information and Notes:

- **ALL HM classes are offered online via e-campus ONLY**
- Hospitality Mgmt. 89 total credits, 99 credits with optional Sustainability Specialization.
- Transfer work from other institutes may also accepted for substitution. Connect with advisor once courses are transferred for approval process.
- It is the student's responsibility to make certain that all prerequisites are met, or instructor approval is granted for courses that require one or both conditions.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all degree requirements are met. The advisor can suggest courses and assist the student in constructing a plan of study, but the student in the end is responsible for assuring all requirements for graduation are complete.
