



Early Childhood Career Development Scholarship

OSU-Cascades offers scholarships, fellowships and awards from many private and public donors throughout our community. Completing this application enables you to compete for the Early Childhood Career Development Scholarship that can be used toward tuition for up to one year while you are enrolled in the OSU-Cascades HDFS major, minor or enrolled in the COCC Early Childhood Education program. As an enrolled student you must be completing the Department of Early Learning and Care qualifications for teacher. This one-year (up to four consecutive terms) award covers resident base tuition and fees for up to 45 credit hours and is up to \$5,043 each term based on enrollment at OSU or up to \$2,269 based on enrollment at COCC. The scholarship also requires a commitment of 12-20 hours per week paid employment in the early childhood education field in Deschutes County. After successful completion of the one year scholarship program, you must aspire to work at least 20 hours per week in the early childhood education field for two years.

Complete this application carefully; follow the instructions. Students may apply any term; please see term deadlines on the scholarship webpage. Qualified applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview, and award recipients will be notified by email.

The scholarship also requires a commitment of 12-20 hours per week paid employment in the early childhood education field in Deschutes County.
