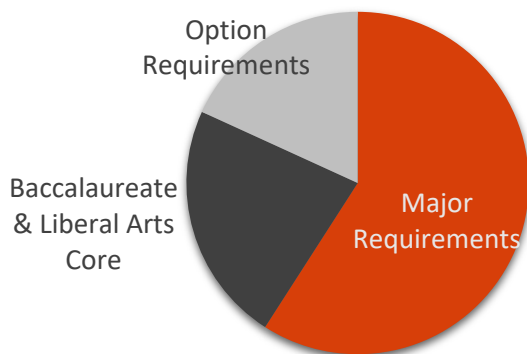

Arts, Media and Technology

Through a sequence of required courses, Arts, Media and Technology students will:

- Create original visual work that exhibits a distinctive, dynamic and unique personal voice.
- Develop written & verbal competencies to describe and analyze visual art and graphic design through writing, conceptual development, research, study of theory and critique of the intent of their own work.
- Develop necessary techniques and execution of form and content relevant to visual communication in 2D, 3D, and 4D mediums.
- Demonstrate competency with industry standards through a professional art or design experience and an embrace of new technologies.
- Develop an original, innovative and articulate body of work for a professional portfolio.
- Focus on ethics in the process of making various forms of visual communication.

Your Bachelor's Degree (BA or BS) in Social Science



- A minimum of 180 credits are required for graduation; 60 must be upper division (300 and 400-level courses).
- A maximum of 135 transfer credits may be applied toward a bachelor's degree at OSU.
- 45 of the last 75 credits must be completed at OSU
