



English Minor

The minor in English is designed for students in any major. Lower division courses are surveys of past to contemporary American authors. The upper division classes explore the connections between literature and culture. Critical thinking, written and oral communication, and collaboration are applicable skills to any major area of study or career field. The minor in English allows students to concentrate in the area of the liberal arts and develop the reading and writing skills often demanded by employers.

English Minor Curriculum (24-28 credits)

- Minor courses cannot be taken with S/U grading and must be graded C- or better.
- College of Liberal Arts majors are allowed to double count minor courses with Bacc core and CLA core requirements but not with major curriculum
