### COCC Transfer Guide

#### HDFS Early Childhood Option

In the HDFS program, you'll address human development across the lifespan and gain the knowledge and skills you need to help improve the human condition. This may include intervening during crises, preventing future crises, helping people access resources, and advocating for changes in the systems that affect the lives of those in need. You can also focus on supporting young children and their families in early childhood settings.

Few careers offer as many opportunities to directly and profoundly impact lives. With an HDFS degree, you'll be ready for professional work or graduate study in fields such as education, HDFS, social work or public administration.

The Early Childhood option prepares students to promote lifelong development, learning, and wellbeing of children and families. Through a focus on the early childhood period from prenatal through age 8 years, students examine dynamics among children, families, schools, communities, and cultures that have lasting impacts throughout life. Practicum and internship experiences prepare students to work directly with children and families in preschools, Head Start programs, child care, early intervention/ early childhood special education, or parent and family support. Graduates also create and implement prevention and intervention programs, and pursue graduate study in fields such as education, special education, counseling, human development and family science, psychology, sociology, and social work.

#### **Oregon State University Graduation Requirements:**

- 180 – total number of credits required to graduate from OSU
- 60 – number of upper division credits required (300-400 level courses)
- 135 – Maximum number of transfer credits
- 45 out of last 75 credits must be completed through OSU credits.
- Maintain a 2.0 or better university GPA
- Max 18 course withdraws (W grade)
- Max 11 credits in PAC (Physical Activity Coursework)

#### **HDFS MAJOR Requirements:**

- OSU Graduation Requirements, Baccalaureate Core & HDFS Major & Option Coursework
- All courses required within the major must be completed with a grade of **C- or higher**.
- First attempt may be completed as S/U grading but must retake for a grade in second attempt.
- PHHS will not accept third course attempts from OSU or transferred from other institutions to meet course requirements within any major.
