### Transfer Planning

### Hospitality Management: Program Overview

The multi-disciplinary degree program prepares you for a wide range of hospitality careers within a corporate setting, in a hospitality operations setting, or as an entrepreneur. The hospitality industry requires college graduates who can go directly into management and can hit-the-ground-running on their first day of work. The hospitality management program at OSU-Cascades provides students with the skills and knowledge to become leaders and innovators in the hospitality industry.

Students will select either OSU-Cascades Campus Hospitality Management (on-campus and online courses) or the OSU E-campus Hospitality Management (online only) when they apply.

#### *NOTE:*

*Some Hospitality Management courses are only offered through OSU E-campus as an Online course.*

### Degree Notes:

To complete a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Hospitality Management students must complete the following degree requirements:

- Early transfer is encouraged to begin lower division HM department courses.
- College of Business Requirements- CoB GPA 2.5, w/grade of C-or higher in Bus. Minor courses
- Hospitality Management majors are required to complete the Business Minor.

## OSU Graduation Requirements

Students pursuing a degree at OSU must meet the following requirements in addition to program and college requirements.

- 180—total number of credits required to graduate from OSU
- 60—number of upper division credits required (300-400 level courses)
- 135—maximum number of credits that will transfer from a community college
- 45 of last 75 credits must be OSU credits
- Maintain a 2.0 or better university GPA
