Psychology: Program Overview

Psychologists are frequently innovators, evolving new approaches from established knowledge to meet changing needs of people and societies. They develop theories and test them through their research. As this research yields new information, these findings become part of the body of knowledge that practitioners call on in their work with clients and patients. Psychology is a tremendously varied field.

To complete a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) or Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Psychology students must complete the following degree requirements:

- OSU Graduation Requirements
- Baccalaureate Core
- College of Liberal Arts Core
- BA or BS Requirements
- Psychology Major Requirements

OSU Graduation Requirements:

Students pursuing a degree at OSU must meet the following requirements in addition to program and college requirements.

180—total number of credits required to graduate from OSU

60—number of upper division credits required (300-400 level courses)

135—maximum number of credits that will transfer from a community college

45 of last 75 credits must be OSU credits

Maintain a 2.0 or better university GPA
