Graduation Requirements:

- 180 total college credits
- 60 upper division credits (64 in major)
- 45 out of last 75 credits must be OSU credits

Social Science Major Core (32-35 credits)

Courses taken to fulfill major requirements **cannot** be used to fulfill Bacc Core, College of Liberal Arts, or option requirements. Most Major and Option courses are 300-400 level and must be taken at OSU. Students should consider 100-200 level courses as pre-req and foundations.

Suggested COCC major pre-reqs include: SOC 204, SP 111, PSY 201, 202, ANTH 103.
