

Little Kits Early Childhood Education Career Scholarship

About the award:

OSU-Cascades and COCC offer scholarships, fellowships and awards from many private and public donors throughout our community. Completing this application enables you to compete for the Little Kits Early Childhood Education Career Scholarship that can be used toward tuition for up to one year while you are enrolled at OSU-Cascades or dually enrolled at COCC. As an enrolled student you must be working on the Early Learning Division, ELD qualifications for teachers. This one-year (up to four consecutive terms) award covers resident base tuition and fees for up to 45 credit hours and is up to \$4,363 each term based on enrollment at OSU or up to \$2,347 based on enrollment at COCC. The scholarship also requires a commitment to 20 hours per week paid employment in the early childhood education field in Central Oregon. After successful completion of the one year scholarship program, you must aspire to work at least 20 hours per week in the early childhood education field for two years.

Complete this application carefully; follow the instructions. Students may apply any term; please see term deadlines on the scholarship webpage. Qualified applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview, and award recipients will be notified by email.
