### 8:30am – Intervarsity Club

InterVarsity club will be associated with the national Christian fellowship InterVarsity. The main purpose of this club is to provide an educational community for followers of Christianity at OSU-Cascades. They are asking for \$745 to start the club, which will go toward books, food for events, a guest speaker, and other educational tools. There is a good amount of interest in the club from bible study groups on campus.

#### 8:45am – Discussion of InterVarsity

The national organization InterVarsity has had some problems with values pertaining to diversity, especially in regard to LGBTQ+ acceptance. The committee worries about providing money to a club associated with the organization, but since there are no membership fees, the educational support of InterVarsity outweighs potential negatives. The club will also be only distantly associated with the organization.

The budget looked good, we decided to make the amount allocated \$750.

Vote to allocate InterVarsity club \$750 passed 6-0-1

#### 9:20am - SNACC

Ski and Snowboard Nordic Alpine Club is chartering as a club and a sport club. Their ask amount is \$4,090 and they have a possible \$1,000 donation coming in. They plan to have practices on Saturdays in order to be open to a large number of students. The budget covers some basic operation costs as well as financially helping members with the investment that comes with winter sports. They may continue the club from winter into spring, depending on the weather.
