Fees and Froyo posters were not distributed to advertise the event, so we moved it one week from the set date in order to provide students adequate time to prepare.

8:15am – Rock Climbing Sports Club

The Rock Climbing Sports Club met with us to request additional funding for their operations. They are looking for \$18,375 to be used in three different ways. The main priority of the club is to pay their climbing coach, the second is to pay for competitors to attend the regional bouldering competition in Reno, and the third is to send people to Colorado to compete in nationals.

8:30am – Rock Climbing Sports Club Discussion

We discussed the possibility of the climbing club fundraising in and around the community. We also learned that several members will already be near Reno during the time of regionals, and other competitors may not be able to go. Since the climbing clubs have had such a good history of management, the ask isn't overly extreme, but SFC can't afford to allocate the full amount. After reviewing our finances, we decided to allocate \$7,675

The vote for the allocation of \$7,675 to the Rock Climbing Sports Club passed 6-0-2
