## 8:00am -- Review Meeting Minutes

### 8:05am – Jade Warner

MLK Day of Service is coming up on January 20<sup>th</sup>. OSU-Cascades will have the opportunity to volunteer alongside the community. There will be afternoon and morning shifts available by signing up through the school website.

There are lobbying days on January 14<sup>th</sup>, February 13<sup>th</sup>, and February 19<sup>th</sup>. If we don't secure approval for the student success center during this lobbying period, we may need to wait another six years before getting approval.

Our Classroom Enhancement Grant is apparently very similar to a grant that already exist to help fund teachers. Our grant is for \$300 while the other is for \$2,000. We discussed several options for distinguishing our grant, including promoting it as a quicker way to obtain small amounts of money, as well as making it more student focused.

### 8:20am – Club Incentives

Elsie had the proposal to provide an incentive program for clubs in order to motivate members to help volunteer on MLK Day. If four members attend, the club will get \$50. If six members attend, they get \$100. If eight members attend, the club will receive \$200. Last year, we allocated \$100 total through the incentive program.

Through discussion, we decided that the reward amounts were reasonable, and the jump from \$100 to \$200 makes sense because eight members of one club would point to that club being very organized.

The vote for the incentive program passed 7-0-1

## 8:45 – ASCC Grad Student Coordinator Hour Increase

Discussion of tabled item: ASCC Graduate Student Coordinator Hour Increase Proposal. Amber requested a weekly hour increase from six to twelve hours in order to keep up with her event planning for grad students. ASCC voted to give her twelve hours a week, SFC decided to explore a way to structure the proposal in order to make it fit a position that started the year as an experimental position. Since Amber is doing well, the hour increase seems reasonable, but we would like to model it after events council, so that we provide funds for 10 hours a week on average, but Amber can choose to flex these hours in order to fit more hours into her busier weeks. The money to fund this would come out of the unallocated funds.

The vote for the hour increase passed 8-1-0
