## 8:00am -- Review Meeting Minutes

### 8:05am – Lauren Glass

Lauren Glass is a campus development applicant requesting funds to attend the American Counseling Association conference in San Diego this April. An OSU-Cascades faculty member is presenting research at this presentation. The total conference budget is over \$900, Lauren is asking for \$700. Her service to campus would take the form of partnering with a counseling and psychology organization to put on for students.

The vote to allocate Lauren \$700 from campus development funds passed 9-0-0

### 8:15am – Psychology Club

Psychology Club is a new charter, hoping to organize a space for those interested in psychology and mental health. The club has plans for weekly meetings along with two events each term. The winter term events include Brain Games on 2/11/2020 and a movie night toward the end of the term. The Psychology Club is hoping to rebrand, which will entail ordering certain items like stress balls and stickers. It is worth noting that the club specifically asked for advice on how to be a successful club. They asked for \$700 to start, but the SFC decided to allocate \$500 after discussion of the line items.
