Esports Club is a new charter with 33 current participating members looking to compete within the National Association of Collegiate Esports (NACE). They are seeking funding for the equipment needed for teams as well as a physical space to host practices and tournaments. Their ask is \$5,776. The club kept prices for the expensive equipment relatively low considering the usual cost for gaming supplies.

Possible locations include a room in the Graduate Research Center, a room in the residence hall, or space in the computer lab (the room in the GRC is the most likely option). This club would be a competitive sports club.
